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CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

ENGLISH: This term students will focus on poetry and rhymes. They will create a rhyming verse, identify the rhyming words the used and recite it to a familiar audience. They will listen while others present their rhyme. Students will express personal opinions about the story and relate it to their experiences.

MATHEMATICS: Students will explore quantities, addition, parts of a whole and sharing collections. They will be creating and answering questions to collect data. The students will also explore the language used to describe a location and create and follow a path on a treasure map.

SCIENCE: This term, students use their senses to explore and observe the weather in their local environment and learn that we can record our observations using symbols. Students observe that weather can change and identify the features that reflect a change in the weather. Students also learn about the impact of daily and seasonal changes on plants and animals.

HASS: Students will developed understandings of their family relationships and backgrounds. They will understand the different structures of families and discuss events of the past, present and future.

VISUAL ARTS: This term, students will experiment with materials to create representations of experiences, observations and imagination, and share and discuss how artworks communicate ideas. The visual arts elements are embedded across the Key Learning Areas.

SPECIALISTS

MUSIC: "Music in our New World" Prep students will explore different styles of music as stimulus for their own music making and responding. They will study a range of instruments and develop singing and aural skills.

HEALTH AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION: In PE, students will demonstrate personal and social skills when working with others and describe their feelings after participating in a range of active games.

In Health, students explore how their bodies are growing and developing, and identify the actions that will keep them healthy, such as diet, hygiene and physical activity.
