CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

ENGLISH: This term students will undertake a novel study of "The One and Only Ivan". They will read, view and comprehend the text to explore how ideas are developed through fictional elements. They will then create, edit and publish a written imaginative text, using typical stages and language features of narrative text.

MATHEMATICS: This term students will be working with place value to write and order decimals including decimals greater than one, use multiplication facts and efficient calculation strategies to multiply large numbers by one- and two-digit numbers and divide by single-digit numbers. They will also conduct repeated chance experiments and list the possible outcomes.

SCIENCE: Students will learn about the different properties of solids, liquids and gases. They will plan, conduct and evaluate an investigation into a variable that affects evaporation.

HASS: Students will learn about the key values of Australia's democratic system of government, particularly the values of freedom, equality, fairness and justice and investigate democratic values and processes in the school community.

ARTS: MEDIA - Students will explore the work of media artists and collaborate to create a stop motion animation using light and shadow to communicate mood and point of view for an audience.

SPECIALISTS

MUSIC: "Around the World with Music"

Year 5 students will continue to compose, perform and respond to music exploring the music making of other cultures. They will develop technical and expressive skills when singing and playing instruments.

LANGUAGES: Students will use the language inspired by the Very Hungry Caterpillar story, to sequence multiple events with days of the week.

STEM: Digital Technologies

Students will investigate the main components of common digital systems and how they connect together to form networks. They will use a micro:bit, a small programmable microcontroller, as a tool to use problem-solving processes to design and create a digital solution that uses a visual programming language.

HEALTH AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION: In Physical Education, students demonstrate skills to work collaboratively and play fairly to solve movement challenges.

In Health, students will continue to explore developmental changes and transitions that occur as they grow older.
