a Glance

Curriculum Overview

English

Students will continue developing their knowledge of letters and sounds as they learn to read and write simple words. They will practise blending sounds when reading, spelling familiar words and sharing ideas through speaking and writing. Students will also create simple texts to retell events and express their thoughts and feelings.

Mathematics

Students will build confidence with counting, sharing, adding and taking away numbers to 10. They will compare the length, weight, capacity and duration of everyday objects and events, and recognise, sort and describe familiar two-dimensional shapes.

Science

Students will use their senses to observe the needs of plants and animals and explore what living things need to survive. They will develop their observation skills by asking questions, recording what they notice and sharing their discoveries like scientists.

HASS

Students will explore the features of familiar places and learn why some places are important to people. They will identify ways they can care for places that are special within their home, school and local community.

The Arts – Visual

Students will explore how artists, including Aboriginal, Torres Strait Islander and Asian artists, represent weather in their artworks.

They will experiment with colour, painting techniques and visual effects to create their own artworks, and share how their artistic choices communicate mood and meaning.
