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## CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

**ENGLISH:** Students will focus on name writing, identifying alphabet letter sounds, and blending and segmenting sounds in words. They will learn to speak confidently in small groups and listen to others. Students will develop the ability to share feelings and thoughts about characters and events in stories.

MATHEMATICS: Students will focus on subitising collections using fingers or dice patterns. They will count groups of objects to 10 and beyond. Students will work on recognising numbers to 10, counting to 20 and backwards to 10, and on comparing small collections to show more or less. They will learn about sorting, simple patterns, sequencing familiar events, comparing the size of objects and using positional language.

**SCIENCE**: Students will examine everyday objects and investigate what they are made of. They will work out which materials are suitable for a particular purpose and explain their findings.

**DRAMA:** Students will explore and perform a role in a short dramatic play. They will describe what happens in the drama.

MUSIC: "Counting the Beat"

Prep students will discover beat by exploring songs, rhymes and games that involve numbers, counting and taking turns. They will use their speaking and singing voices.
