a Glance

Curriculum Overview

English

Students will read a range of texts and learn how authors organise information to explain how things are done. They will share their opinions using reasons and supporting details, and create their own procedural texts while building confidence when speaking to an audience.

Mathematics

Students will solve addition and subtraction problems to 20 using a range of strategies. They will investigate equal sharing, compare and measure everyday objects, and recognise, sort and describe two-dimensional and three-dimensional shapes.

Science

Students will observe changes in the weather and the environment and describe how these changes affect everyday life. They will compare observations, ask questions and communicate what they discover.

HASS

Students will investigate natural, managed and built environments within their local area. They will learn about the weather and seasons and explore how people can care for places in their community.

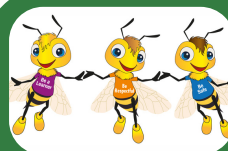

Specialists

"Different Places" - Students will explore a range of songs, rhymes and chants based on the theme of different places as stimulus for music making and responding.



My Safety, My Responsibilities - Students will explore ways they are becoming more independent and identify strategies to keep themselves safe in a range of everyday situations. They will practise asking for help, making safe choices and taking responsibility for their own wellbeing.

Ropes and Rhymes - Students will develop coordination and confidence through skipping activities and movement games. They will explore how physical activity affects their bodies while improving balance, rhythm and teamwork skills



Students will explore how digital technologies are used in everyday life and collect simple information from their classmates to represent in different ways. They will begin creating simple digital solutions through age-appropriate coding activities using Blue-Bot robots and learn how to use technology safely and responsibly.
