CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

ENGLISH: Students create, rehearse and present a multimodal procedure on a creation based on ideas in George's Marvellous Medicine.

MATHEMATICS: Students are working towards quick recall of addition and subtraction facts and will practise part-part-whole for problem solving. They will be counting and calculating to and from 1000 by the end of the year.

SCIENCE: Students are learning about materials and their properties in order to combine different materials to create an object.

HASS: Present Connections to Places—Students will explore the following inquiry question: *How are people connected to their place and other places?*

SPECIALISTS

MUSIC: "Save the World"

Year 2 students will explore a range of songs, rhymes and chants based on the theme of Earth's resources as stimulus for music making and responding.

LANGUAGES: Students will begin to learn about Japan and its culture, using simple vocabulary to greet people and introduce themselves. Students will study several specific festivals held in February and March in Japan.

TECHNOLOGIES: DESIGN

Students will explore how technologies use forces to create movement in products. They will investigate spinning toys from around the world and analyse construction and movement. They will generate design ideas, using simple drawings and produce a spinning toy. Students will be asked to video their toy working and evaluate its design and production.

HEALTH AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION: In Movement, students will develop the object-control skills of rolling, catching, pat bouncing and throwing through active participation in activities, games and movement challenges. They will also apply rules and fair play practices.

In Health, students will investigate the concept of what health is and which foods and activities make them healthy. They will also identify the actions that they can apply to keep themselves and others healthy and safe in their classroom.
