Curriculum Overview

English

Students will read a variety of persuasive texts to understand how authors present arguments and influence an audience. They will develop their own persuasive writing by selecting appropriate language to express opinions and support their ideas.

Mathematics

Students will extend their understanding of decimals, fractions and place value while solving practical financial problems. They will measure length, mass, capacity, temperature, perimeter and area, and investigate angles and geometric shapes.

Science

Students will investigate the properties of different materials and learn how to conduct a fair scientific investigation. They will collect, organise and interpret data to identify patterns and communicate their findings.

HASS

Students will explore how people use environments and consider ways communities can care for places more sustainably. They will examine how human actions affect the environment and evaluate possible solutions.

The Arts – Visual

Students will investigate pattern, texture and surface in artworks, including artworks created by First Nations Australian artists. They will apply these techniques to produce their own visual artworks.

Specialists

"Rad Recorders" - Students will compose, perform and respond to music through recorder playing and singing. They will explore how musical elements of known songs can be reorganised to create new music.



Housing - Through the concept of housing, we will look at culturally specific aspects of schools in Japan. The students will learn to use basic questions and answers around identifying rooms and furniture. They will also explain the functions of these rooms.

Netiquette - Students will use digital technologies to design and create solutions to authentic problems through coding and problem-solving activities. They will continue developing responsible online behaviours by learning how to create secure passwords and protect personal information.



Bat, Catch, HOWZAT - Students will further develop striking and fielding skills while applying movement strategies during team games. They will strengthen cooperation, communication and problem-solving skills in a range of physical activities.

Students will design and create an interactive digital quiz using Scratch programming. They will apply the problem-solving process to develop digital solutions while strengthening their understanding of cyber safety and responsible online practices.
