Curriculum Overview

English

Students will explore how persuasive language and advertising techniques influence audiences. They will analyse how authors use language to create emotional responses and develop their own persuasive speaking and writing using well-supported arguments.

Mathematics

Students will strengthen their understanding of fractions, decimals and percentages while solving real-world mathematical problems. They will also investigate measurement, area, angles and three-dimensional objects using efficient problem-solving strategies.

Science

Students will investigate electrical circuits and explore how electricity can be transferred and transformed. They will examine how different energy sources generate electricity and apply their understanding through practical investigations.

HASS

Students will investigate the diversity of countries around the world by exploring their environments, cultures and populations. They will compare how people live in different places and examine the factors that influence communities across the globe.

The Arts – Media

Students will create documentary-style films that share the stories of members of the school community. They will develop skills in planning, filming, editing and working collaboratively while using a range of digital media techniques.

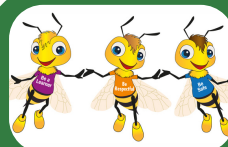

Specialists

"Rhythmic Riot" - Students will compose, perform and respond to a range of styles of music. They will explore the concept of ostinatos with rhythmic and melodic patterns.



Family - Through the exploration family we students will be asked to describe the number in their family, the family make up and explicitly describe details about individual family members.

Transitioning - Students will prepare for the transition to secondary school by exploring the opportunities and challenges that accompany this change. They will develop practical strategies to support their wellbeing, resilience and confidence.



All Codes Football - Students will refine specialised movement skills used in football codes while applying tactical thinking and teamwork in game situations. They will evaluate strategies and work collaboratively to achieve successful outcomes.

Students will investigate how computers represent and process digital information, including images and data. Using micro:bit technology, they will design, program and test digital solutions while collecting and analysing data. Students will also deepen their understanding of computer networks, cyber security and the importance of creating strong, secure passwords.
