This funding will be used to


- Ensure 100% of students are at or above National Minimum Standard or are engaged in a program commensurate with their identified learning needs
- Attain target of 50% of students in upper two bands in reading for both Year 3 and Year 5
- Attain target of 40% of students in upper two bands in numeracy for both Year 3 and Year 5
- Ensure that 100% of students will be engaged in high quality instruction that consolidates learning
- Ensure all teaching staff and paraprofessionals will be provided support to embed high-yield teaching strategies
- Provide “Enrolling Families” program to best prepare students and parents for Prep in 2018
- Employ RTI model, targeting intervention through: data analysis, consistent core instruction, monitoring progress and supplementary and intensive intervention.
- Engage a pedagogy coach in collaboration with the Nerang Alliance of Schools to support program provision in and support for Pre-school programs in feeder centres and to liaise with service providers in local universities.

Our initiatives include

- Embedding direct instruction method for the delivery of mathematics
- Embedding consistent reading instruction and monitoring practices from Prep – Year 6
- Embedding consolidation techniques in all classrooms
- Deployment of skilled personnel to model and provide feedback to teachers’ classroom practices
- Provision of time for teachers to collaborate in Professional Learning Teams
- Provision of time to develop and quality assure high quality teaching resources to support whole school Explicit Improvement Agenda.
- Provision of high-quality professional learning opportunities to all staff through engagement of pedagogy leaders
- Provision of “Enrolling Families” program for incoming Prep students and their families
- Further refine assessment techniques to precisely deploy available resources

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Coaching and mentoring staff, resourcing the RTI agenda and providing time for teachers to collaborate \$34000
- Engage Pedagogy coach for Nerang Alliance of Schools \$16000
- Supplement cost of engagement of pedagogy leaders to support teachers \$19405
- Engage staff to support delivery of programs in literacy and numeracy and “Enrolling Families” program \$117000



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
