CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

ENGLISH: Students will be studying, reading and writing using persuasive and narrative texts. They will focus on reading comprehension and speaking through a variety of texts, particularly Charlotte's Web.

MATHEMATICS: This term we will be focusing on multiplication tables, measurement, place value, statistics and probability.

SCIENCE: Students will be exploring living and non-living things.

HASS: Students will look at symbols, events, celebrations and commemorations that make a community unique.

MEDIA: Students will be exploring media artworks and then creating a media piece.

SPECIALISTS

MUSIC: Instrument- recorder. Reading notes from the music staff. Elements of music -treble clef, bar lines, line notes and space notes. New rhythmic elements $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{2}$; dynamics pp and ff

STEM: What Digital Systems do you use? (DiT unit 2)

Students will explore and use a range of peripheral devices. They will identify the appropriate digital system or peripheral device to meet needs at home, in school or the community. They will create secret messages and codes as a way to represent data to send to peers. They will provide a digital solution to a problem.

HEALTH AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION: Students will practise and refine fundamental movement skills to perform long rope and partner skipping activities and solve individual skipping challenges. In Health, students will explore bullying behaviours and strategies to reduce it, and identify people who can help them make good decisions and stay safe.
