



## CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

**ENGLISH:** Students will read a familiar narrative, examine and analyse language features and techniques used by the author. They will create a new chapter, using a variety of language features to ensure greater engagement for their intended audience.

**MATHEMATICS:** Number and place value: Students are working towards choosing appropriate strategies for calculations involving multiplication and division. Chance: Identifying and explaining chance events.

**SCIENCE:** Weathering and Erosion: Students will explore natural processes and human activity that cause weathering and erosion of Earth's surface. Students will make observations and predict consequences of future occurrences and human activity.

**HASS:** Sustainability: Students will identify and describe the interconnections between people and the environment

**MEDIA:** Students will explore representations of people from their community to develop animated characters. The students will create a character animation to deliver an audio recording of a short, humorous poem.

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## SPECIALISTS
