This funding will be used to

- Support all indigenous students achieve comparatively with non-indigenous students in English and Maths.
- Improve student relative gain in years 3 to 5 comparative with national performance (NAPLAN).
- Improve student learning outcomes in the areas of reading and numeracy with a target of 50% or higher of students achieving in the U2B (NAPLAN) in both years 3 and 5.
- Support learning in English, Maths and Science with 80% of students (years 1-6) achieving a 'C' or above.
- Promote student learning and teacher capacity in the area of STEAM.
- Support teacher capability and build leadership for differentiation, curriculum and pedagogical expertise with two Inclusion Mentors to support teachers, Curriculum Leader and a Teacher mentor (Numeracy P-6).
- Provide a safe and welcoming environment for all stakeholders through Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL).

Our initiatives include

- Increasing teacher capacity in the use of digital pedagogies through iPad classes and teacher mentoring around best practice literacy and numeracy in the classroom.
- Building the capacity of teachers and teacher aides to engage all students in learning through the implementation of our pedagogical framework and personalised learning approach.
- Embedding consistent reading instruction inline with the School Reading Framework.
- Promoting inquiry learning in mathematics to improve student problem solving skills.
- Continuing the journey towards becoming an *Inclusive School* through supporting students with disabilities in the classroom in alignment with the State Schools Inclusion Policy.
- Year level collaborative planning supported by the Curriculum Leader to achieve consistency and clarity inline with the Australian Curriculum.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Improve student learning outcomes and staff capacity in the area of STEAM through the employment of a STEAM teacher and resourcing/teacher release to team teach. \$25000
- Build the capacity of teachers to teach to The Australian Curriculum through whole year level planning/assessment supported by Curriculum Leader and DP (Curriculum). \$45360
- Improve student learning in literacy/numeracy by implementing a response to intervention approach aligning teacher aides with Inclusion Mentors and teachers to target individual student needs. \$ 46045
- Releasing teachers to participate in scheduled student learning data sessions with the leadership team to inform future teaching direction - 4 mid term session/year/per teacher. \$27000
- Build the capacity of all staff around age appropriate pedagogies with the Nerang Alliance of Schools. \$10000
- Implementing the Gilston SS mentoring framework to support teaching in literacy/numeracy. \$20000
- Promote digital 21st Century learners through technology enhancement and access. \$13000
